

Carpet Underlayment Paradise Wool

Paradise Wool is a naturally resilient floor underlayment made from 100% sheep's wool that does not break down like typical underlayment. Its antimicrobial treatment prevents mold, fungus, and bacteria growth if airborne spores are present. This product can be installed under laminate, engineered, and hardwood floors. Paradise Wool prevents sound transmission through floors and helps to prevent squeaks in hardwood floors, making hardwood floors quieter than ever.

Additionally, Paradise Wool is capable of lowering reverberation times when placed under a carpet. This creates a more serene environment in what may be a loud and echoic space.



Applications:

- Increase floor STC and IIC, when placed underneath hard wood or laminate flooring
- Reduce reverberation time in a room, when placed under area rugs

Installation:

Roll out Paradise Wool onto the sub floor with the polypropylene film facing up. Start along one wall and cut the pieces to length. If you are installing this material over a concrete sub floor, use a strong packaging tape to seal the butted seams. This seam taping process is not recommended when installing on top of a wood sub floor. Once the Paradise Wool is laid down, install your finished flooring directly on top.

When installing under an area rug or wall to wall carpeting, cut the Paradise Wool about an inch shorter than the rug on each side. Place the wool under the area rug film side down; if the rug slides on top of the wool, use double sided tape on the wool to hold the rug in place.
